



## **Maine Troop Greeters & Museum Member Benefits Statement**

### **Membership**

The Maine Troop Greeters & Museum is a volunteer organization established to greet and host troops passing through Bangor International Airport.

A member of the Maine Troop Greeters is defined as a volunteer who has read the Standards of Conduct document, agrees with the policies set forth and has signed the Conduct Agreement form which is included in the membership packet. This will be explained by a Membership person prior to greeting troops.

### **Benefits of Membership**

A member of the Maine Troop Greeters & Museum has the opportunity to participate in the leadership of the organization by serving on committees, voting on policies and directors, and having the opportunity to attend all meetings of the organization where their voice can be heard, dependent on their category.

A member will also be notified of confirmed Troop flights through the organization's call service.

Because the Maine Troop Greeters & Museum is a recognized non-profit, 501 (c)(3), organization, members are allowed to deduct their travel expenses for tax purposes. A description of all membership categories' benefits are listed on the attached Benefits Chart.
